

Connection Problem with email on iMAC running 10.14.6

Problem:

1. Intermittent display of triangle with asterisk next to my mac mail accounts (private and one Google account) on iMac; all ok on both iPhone and iPad and AirBook. All are on the same network.
2. Problem appears on both Wi-Fi and cable
3. Two accounts with same (private) domain name work, and triangles come and go, but had to change to checking em to one minute to receive mail
4. Cannot add new em account; get message: unable to verify account name or password
5. When triangle shows, outgoing server is offline
6. IF e.g. the triangle shows up on my inbox account, it will also show up on the JUNK folder and the TRASH folder

Actions Tried:

1. Removed all old email passwords from key chain
2. Spoke to domain provider (Digital Host) and they checked their end (all OK), and took control of my computer em online and tried various server and port settingsdid not work
3. Checked Webmail, and account that I cannot place on my iMac appears there, and in and out mail works perfectly
4. Tried to set up em account on Thunderbird, but was rejected due to same message (unable to verify account name or password)
5. Ran Connection Doctor and get either "Trying to log in to this SMTP account (or IMAP account) failed"
6. I have rebooted the router,
7. Restarted my Mac multiple times,
8. Used ONYX for system cleanup, and ran MacCleaner
9. Removed a thunderbolt network link (note being used)
10. Removed all automatic downloads on my iPhone to reduce download conflicts at the server (with fetch commands),
11. Removed mail related PLIST files per: <http://osxdaily.com/2016/05/14/fix-wifi-connection-timeout-error-mac/>.
12. Removed SpamSieve

Possible Clues:

1. When I opened one of the existing accounts, and reset it **without** a password I did not get the Unable to Verify message. Unfortunately I do not know anyway to set up a NEW em account without a password.
2. I have NOT reset all of my key chain access, as there seem to be a lot of them.
3. I do not have em in iCloud
4. No connection problem with browsers
