

1. Download CyberDuck for Mac
2. Download OpenSSH on your iPhone through Cydia
3. Open up CyberDuck on your Mac
4. Go to SBSettings and make sure SSH is on.
5. Click open connection in CyberDuck
6. Make sure the top bar says “ SFTP (SSH File Transfer Protocol)”
7. Then under server type your iPhone’s IP address which can be viewed under SBSettings. Both devices must be on the same network.
8. For username put “ root “ for password put “ alpine “ Both jus like that.
9. Click connect.
10. Hit the arrow pointing up that is above the Modified colum till you can not go any farther.
11. Then navigate to Applications/BiteSMS/
12. Now copy all the files over exactly as they are and hit continue when it asks if you want to replace the files already there
13. Your done! No need to even respring! Though you may want to quit the app by dauble tapping the home button and holding down the BiteSMS app till it jiggles and completely killing the app!
