## HERE'S HOW TO ENTER

**FOR ALL APPLICANTS:** A check made out to Washington Square Outdoor Art Exhibit, Inc. for the booth fee (**refundable**, if application is rejected). See Registration Form below and prices on reverse side. Payment is also accepted via the PayPal/Credit Card link on our website, [www.wsoae.org](http://www.wsoae.org). *NOTE: Applicants from outside the United States must submit American Express Money Orders in U.S. dollars. Canadians may use the Royal Bank of Canada.*

**In addition, for first-time applicants or veterans returning after an absence of two years or more,** a second check for \$20 made out to Washington Square Outdoor Art Exhibit, Inc. for the Jury Fee (**non-refundable**).

**Also, for first-time applicants or veterans returning after an absence of two years or more.** Five images of your work in each medium that you plan to exhibit, including one of your display. These images may be sent to us as JPEGs via e-mail or, on a disc by snail mail, labelled with your name and with medium and dimensions specified. We will also accept slides or photographs, if necessary. Please note: only work typified by the submitted images may be exhibited. WSOAE reserves the right to refuse exhibition of work that is inconsistent with the submitted images.

**Also, For first-time sculptors and craftspersons or veteran exhibitors in these categories returning after an absence of two years or more.** A brief description of the methods and materials you personally use to create your work.

## WHAT ELSE YOU NEED TO KNOW

- ▶ For the Spring Show, registration and images for jurying are due by April 16, 2014. Acceptances will be mailed no later than April 30th.
- ▶ For the Fall Show, registration and images for jurying are due by July 22, 2014. Acceptances will be mailed no later than August 6th.
- ▶ Applications received after the deadline dates will be considered as circumstances permit. The earlier applications are received, the sooner you will be notified of acceptance.
- ▶ You may exhibit work **only in the categories in which you are accepted**. Signing of all work is encouraged and all work must be priced and for sale. The sale of T-shirts is prohibited.

You must agree to participate in **all days of the exhibit** for which you have contracted.
